Twenty-first Century Scholars program and receive...

FREE COLLEGE TUITION!

Indiana started the Twenty-first Century Scholars program in 1990 to ensure that every student can afford a college education. Income-eligible 7th and 8th graders who enroll in the program and fulfill a pledge of good citizenship are guaranteed the cost of four years of college tuition at any participating public college or university in Indiana.

If you attend a private or an independent institution, the state will award an amount comparable to that of a public institution. If you attend a participating proprietary (private career) school, the state will award a tuition scholarship equal to that of Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana.

As a Twenty-first Century Scholar, you can receive free support services throughout junior high and high school such as college visits, career workshops, summer programs, and much more. Once you get to college, Twenty-first Century Scholars receive support to finish their college degrees.
